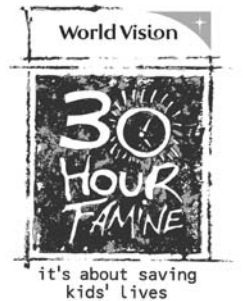
YMCA Sunday Open House
